

Laurent El Ghaoui graduated from Ecole Polytechnique (Palaiseau, France) in 1985, and obtained his PhD in Aeronautics and Astronautics at Stanford University in March 1990. He was a faculty member of the Ecole Nationale Supérieure de Techniques Avancées (Paris, France) from 1992 until 1999, and held part-time teaching appointments at Ecole Polytechnique within the Applied Mathematics department and Université de Paris-I (La Sorbonne) in the Mathematics in Economy program. In 1998, I was awarded the Bronze Medal for Engineering Sciences, from the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique, France. He joined the UC Berkeley EECS faculty in April 1999 as an Acting Associate Professor, and obtained tenure in May 2001. He obtained a CAREER award in 2001.

Laurent is interested in decision-making under uncertainty, with applications ranging from air traffic control to molecular biology and finance. His most recent project involves the statistical analysis of online news, and its visualization.
